

2016 ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

In 1983, with dreams of raising their young family on a farm, Tony and Herta Peju bought thirty acres of vines in the famed Rutherford district of the Napa Valley. Since then, the Peju family has maintained a meticulous focus on the land, fostering sustainable and environmental consciousness across their five estates. Still family-owned and operated with daughters Lisa and Ariana poised to take the helm, Peju Winery has become an integral piece of the Napa Valley landscape.

VINTAGE

2016 was the fifth consecutive year that Mother Nature gifted Los Carneros with a nearly perfect growing season. Its cool fog and breezes from the San Pablo Bay create the ideal conditions for growing complex Pinot Noir grapes. The season started early with a warm winter and normal precipitation levels. Temperatures cooled down in late August allowing the remaining berries to develop intense and balanced fruit. The 2016 vintage produced a remarkably light yield resulting in a higher concentration of flavor in each berry. Our 2016 wines are showcasing to be increasingly aromatic, vibrant and lush.

TASTING

Alluring aromas of strawberry-rhubarb pie, sweet berry candy and light navel orange introduce the nose of our lively and refreshing Rosé of Pinot. Hints of juicy honeysuckle and tart nectarine integrate into layers of white peach and mouthwatering melon leading to a crisp, fresh finish imbued with bright mineral tones.
